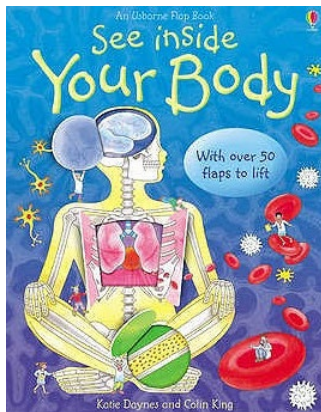
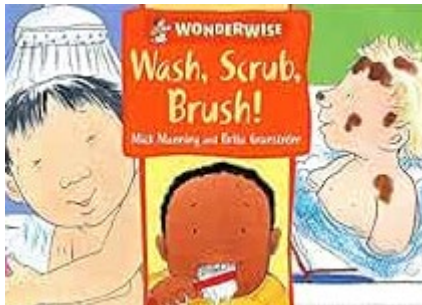


November
