### **RE: Free Breakfast Club Programme**

I am delighted to share some exciting news with you. From September 2026, Keyingham Primary School will be taking part in the Government's Free Breakfast Club Programme.

This means that all children in Reception (FS2) to Year 6 will be able to attend a free breakfast club session each morning from 8:00am to 8:30am, helping them start the school day feeling settled, nourished and ready to learn.

If you are not familiar with the programme, the Government is currently rolling out free breakfast clubs across selected primary schools in England. The aim is to ensure that all children have access to a healthy breakfast and a positive start to the school day, whilst also providing additional support for families through free childcare before school.

As part of this new provision, our current Bagel Bar offer at morning drop-off will come to an end and from September 2026, breakfast will instead be provided through the free breakfast club session.

### **Who can attend?**

The free breakfast club will be available to all children in FS2 to Year 6 and will run each school day from 8:00am until 8:30am.

Unfortunately, the Government funding does not extend to Nursery (FS1) children. FS1 children can still attend our breakfast club provision, however this will remain a paid service.

We will also continue to offer our existing breakfast club provision from 7:30am to 8:00am for families who require an earlier drop-off.

### **Breakfast Offer**

All children attending the breakfast club will have access to a healthy breakfast. Initially, this will include:

- A selection of cereals
- Toast/Bages/Crumpets
- Fresh fruit
- Water and milk

We will monitor uptake and gather feedback during the first few weeks before developing a longer-term breakfast menu based on children's preferences.

## Booking Arrangements

To ensure we have appropriate staffing and food provision in place each day, all breakfast club places must be booked in advance via Arbor.

Bookings must be made by 12:00 noon on the day before attendance.

As part of the programme expectations, children should attend the full breakfast club session from 8:00am until 8:30am. We therefore ask that places are only booked if your child will be attending for the entirety of the session.

A breakfast club session will be created on Arbor specifically for this week. If you would like your child to attend, please book them onto the session in the usual way. We will notify you when it becomes live on Arbor next week.

This trial will allow us to evaluate how the provision works in practice, gather feedback from children and families, and ensure everything is in place for a successful launch in September.

We are incredibly excited to be able to offer this opportunity to our children and families and look forward to welcoming many more children into school for a positive start to their day.
