RE: Free Breakfast Club Programme

Following our recent letter about the Government's Free Breakfast Club Programme, I would like to thank everyone who has already completed the interest form and those families who took part in our trial week this week.

It was wonderful to see an encouraging increase in the number of children attending breakfast club during the trial. The children settled quickly, enjoyed spending time with their friends before the school day began and, of course, made the most of the breakfast on offer! As we prepare for the full launch in September 2026, we hope to see even more families making use of this fantastic free provision.

Starting the day with a healthy breakfast and a calm, structured start can have a real impact on children's wellbeing and learning. Children who attend breakfast club often arrive in class feeling settled, ready to learn and prepared for the day ahead. It also provides valuable opportunities for children to socialise with friends, develop independence and begin the school day in a relaxed and positive environment. For families, the programme also offers the reassurance of free childcare from 8:00am to 8:30am, helping to support morning routines and making the start of the school day that little bit easier.

Breakfast Club Reminder

As a reminder:

- The free breakfast club is available to all children in FS2 to Year 6.
- The session runs every school day from 8:00am until 8:30am.
- Places must be booked via Arbor by 12:00 noon on the previous day.
- Children should attend the full session to gain the greatest benefit from the provision.

Changes to Breakfast Club and After School Club Charges

Whilst we are delighted to be able to offer the new free breakfast club session from 8:00am to 8:30am, I would also like to make parents aware of some changes to the charges for our extended wraparound care provision from September 2026.

The Government funding only covers the free breakfast club session between 8:00am and 8:30am. Our earlier breakfast club provision from 7:30am to 8:00am, together with our after-school club, continues to be fully funded by the school.

Following a review of staffing, food costs and the overall cost of providing high-quality wraparound care, we have made the difficult decision to increase the charges for these paid sessions from September. This is the first review of our pricing for some time and will help ensure that we can continue to provide a safe, engaging and sustainable provision for all families.

Please find the new charges below, which will come into effect from 1 September 2026.

Breakfast Club (8:00am-8:30am) FS2 to Year 6	Free including breakfast	
Enrichment Club (3.15pm-4.30pm) All years	£4.20	
Afterschool Club (3.15-5.00pm) All years	£5.20	
Afterschool Club (3.15-5.30pm) All years	£6.20	Not available on a Friday
Afterschool Club (3.15-6.00pm) All years	£7.20	Not available on a Friday

We appreciate that any increase in cost can be challenging, and we thank you for your understanding and continued support as we strive to provide the very best care for our children before and after the school day.

Many families are able to reduce the cost of wraparound care by using the Government's Tax-Free Childcare scheme. If you think you may be eligible, or if you already have a Tax-Free Childcare account and would like to use this to pay for your child's breakfast or after-school club sessions, please speak to Miss Kay or Mrs Harrison. They will be happy to advise you on how the scheme works at Keyingham Primary School and answer any questions you may have.
